The library owns not only volumes (107,301) Italian and foreign magazines and periodicals (92,288), but also manuscripts (1,150) including important collections of letters and missives. These manuscripts are collected and preserved in special sections, namely the historical, documentary, literary, and ecclesiastic sections. The autographs preserved in the Lybrary are also worth considering, as is the section containing precious and rare Incunabola (20) and Cinquecentine (820), that is books dating back to the XVth and XVIth century respectively.
